Scholarship Application Guidelines

To be eligible to receive the Warner and District Agricultural Society Scholarship all applicants must follow the following Guidelines and complete the Scholarship Form.

1. Applicant must have attended Warner School for their entire secondary education, grades 10 through 12.
2. Preference will be given to applicants accepted to and currently enrolled in a minimum two year Agriculture, Agri-Science, Environmental, Management (Marketing or Finance) or directly related Agricultural program of studies at a post secondary institution or plan to pursue a career in a rural community. Other applicants may also be considered.
3. Other qualifications will be taken into consideration. This scholarship is not given solely on academic standing, although this will be looked at. Other considerations may be the need for financial assistance, the scholastic attitude at the high school level, school and community involvement and volunteerism.
4. Complete applications and **two references** must be received by the Warner and District Agricultural Society by **June 30** of the application year.
5. A copy of the grade 12 students Transcript (Final Marks) must be received by the Warner and District Agricultural Society by **September 1**.
6. Presentation of this award will take place at the Warner School Awards Ceremony in the fall.
